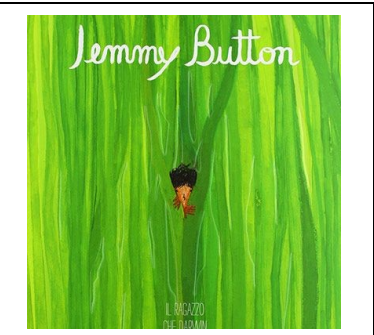




Year 3 — Term 2

English	Using Jemmy Button as a stimulus, the children will be writing setting descriptions and the features for a setting description. These include, alliteration, expanded noun phrases, powerful verbs and adverbs, prepositions, coordinating and subordinating conjunctions.
Maths	In maths we are continuing with addition and subtraction. The children are learning how to add and subtract 2 and 3 digit number with exchanging . We will move onto multiplication and division. The children will recap the 2,5 and 10 times table and learn 3,6 and 8 .
Science	Our unit is animals and skeletons. The children will learn that animals including humans get the nutrients that they need from food, balanced diet, internal and external skeletons , name the parts of a human skeleton and the uses of these bones.
Geography	The children are learning about rivers. We will start with the processes of a water cycle. Then the children will learn about the human and physical features of a river, major river locations and describe the different ways in which rivers are used.
PSHE	This terms unit is valuing differences. The children will be learning about recognising and respecting diversity and being respectful and tolerant, including British Values.
Music	We are continuing to listen to the music and considering the narrative it could represent and pay attention to the dynamics, pitch and tempo and how they change. We will also be practising for the carol concert.
Computing	We will begin with online safety and then move onto use spreadsheets. Throughout the year we will continue to revisit online safety.
RE	The children are exploring the question 'What do different people believe about God'? We will look at different religions and people's views.
PE	This term the children will be taking part in weekly swimming lessons on a Monday. Additionally, children will be doing the daily mile.
Art/DT	In DT this half term, the children will be learning about food technology. We are focusing on a healthy and varied diet and the children will be making a healthy snack
MFL	In Spanish we will be looking at the pronunciation and phonics within the language pupils will have the knowledge and skills to be able to introduce themselves, say how they feel and have a wider appreciation for the country/countries where Spanish is spoken.
