

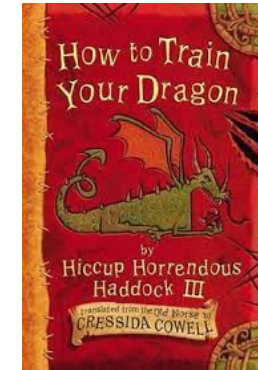


Year 4 — Term 1

English	In English, we will be learning how to write a set of instructions about our core text, as well as writing a poem about dragons.
Maths	In Maths, we will be learning about place value, partitioning numbers to 10,000 and understanding the value of ten thousands, thousands, hundreds, tens and ones.
Science	In Science, we will be learning about Carl Linnaeus and the system of classification. We will be looking at classification keys and classifying different types of leaves and animals.
History	In History, we will be learning about where the Vikings came from, why they came to Britain and what happened when they invaded.
PSHE	In PSHE, we will be learning about healthy relationships and how to look after ourselves and others.
Music	In Music, we will be learning about how to develop our singing technique with music based on the Vikings.
Computing	In Computing, we will be learning how to stay safe online and learning how to do some basic coding using PurpleMash.
RE	In RE, we will be answering the question 'What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain', looking at Hindu beliefs and understanding how Hindus show their beliefs.
PE	In PE, we will be learning about Gymnastics and Fitness. We will be looking at ways to balance and creating a routine, and learning how to improve our fitness.
Art/DT	In DT, we will be making dragon eyes using clay. We will be using a variety of different techniques to mold the clay resemble scales and using painting techniques .
MFL	In Spanish, we will be learning how to introduce ourselves, Numbers to 20 and basic Spanish pronunciation.

**Core Text**
