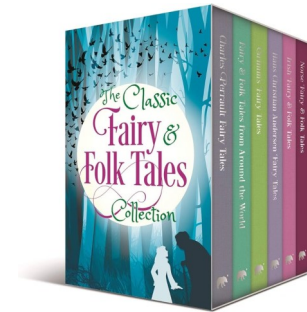




Year 2 — Term 4

English	In writing, we will be exploring a variety of traditional tales and the language they use. We will then use this to rewrite our own traditional tale.
Maths	In maths, we will learning about mass, capacity and temperature. We will be comparing, ordering and measuring different masses and capacities.
Science	In science, we will be learning about 'Animals and their needs'. We will be learning about how humans and animals stay clean and healthy.
Geography	In Geography, we will be answering the question, 'Why is our world wonderful?' We will be learning about landmarks and oceans and exploring our local area.
PSHE	In PSHE, we will be learning about 'Rights and Respect'. We will be discussing how to get on with others and how we can look after our environment.
Music	In music, we will be exploring tempo and dynamics while learning to sing and play an instrument at the same time.
Computing	In computing, we will be recapping how to stay safe online and learning how to search the internet using effective searching.
RE	In RE, we will be continuing to answer the question, 'How and why do we celebrate special and sacred times?'
PE	In PE, we will be learning how to send and receive with our hands and with a stick. We will be develop our throwing, catching and passing techniques.
Art/DT	In art we will be using levers and linkages to make a moving picture based on a well-known traditional tale using a sliding mechanism.

Core Text



This term, we will be reading a range of traditional tales including: The Ugly Duckling, The Three Little Pigs, Little Red Riding Hood and Cinderella.

In reading lessons, the children will be: identifying and exploring key vocabulary, beginning to find evidence in the text to answer 'how' and 'why' questions and learning to navigate the text using paragraphs, subtitles and other structural features.
