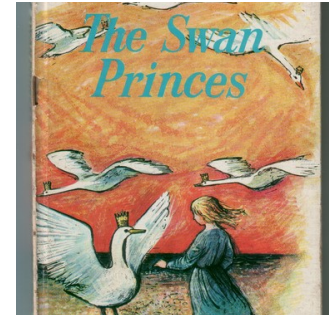




Year R — Term 3
