

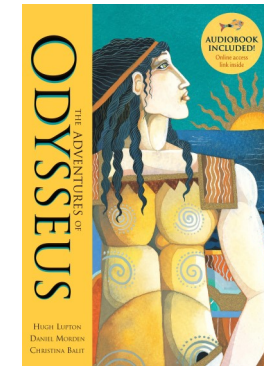


Year 5 — Term 3

English	We will be using descriptive techniques to write a diary entry in role as a character before using our newly learnt knowledge to write a Greek myth of our own.
Maths	In maths we will be learning how to use formal methods of multiplication and division before moving on to the second half of our fractions topic where we will be learning how to multiply fractions.
Science	We will be learning about lifecycles. We will be naming the parts of a flower before exploring and comparing the lifecycles of: plants, mammals, birds, amphibians and insects.
History	We will be learning to answer the question, 'What did the Greeks do for us?' We will be learning about the Greek Gods and Goddesses, the Ancient Greek Olympics, democracy and exploring the differences between how Athens and Sparta were governed.
PSHE	We will be learning about 'keeping safe'. We will be learning how to spot bullying, how to be safe online and about the dangers of some common habits.
Computing	We will be recapping how to stay safe online before moving on to designing, creating and evaluating our own games using a program called 2DIY 3D.
RE	We will be beginning to answer the question, 'If God is everywhere, why go to a place of worship?' We will be learning about the features and purposes of Churches and Mandirs.
PE	This term the children will be taking part in forest school and learning about dance.
Art/DT	We will be learning all about Greek pots before designing, making and evaluating our own using different techniques of working with clay.
MFL	In Spanish we will be continuing to learn about habitats and animals that live there before moving on to learn days of the week and months in Spanish.

Core Text



This term, we will be reading 'The Adventures of Odysseus' by Hugh Lupton.

In reading lessons, the children will be: identifying and exploring key vocabulary, finding evidence in the text to answer 'how' and 'why' questions as well as using inference and prediction skills to deepen their understanding of the text.
