



Hedgehog (Year 1) Class — Term 1

English

In English, we are reading How to Find Gold. We will be talking about our ideas, retelling stories and writing sentences using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces and will begin to use description in our writing.

Maths

In Maths, we will be learning to understand place value within 10 and adding and subtracting within 10.

Science

In Science, our topic is 'Animal Kingdom. We will learn about human bodies, keeping healthy and learn more about animal classes.

History

In History, our topic is called 'How am I making History?' In this topic, we explore what it was like for children in the past and think about how we remember special events.

PSHE

In PSHE, our topic is called 'Me and My Relationships' where we talk about our emotions and learn how to make friends.

Music

In Music, we will learn about pulse and rhythm. We will tap out beats and sing a variety of songs.

Computing

In Computing, we will learn how to log in to Purple Mash and how to be safe online.

RE

In RE, we will learn about who a Christian is and what they believe. We will also look at Diwali.

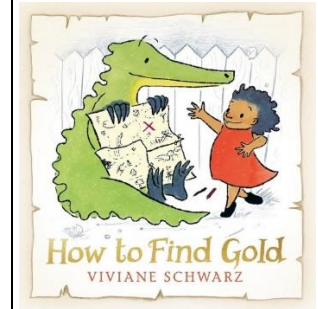
PE
