




Rabbit class — Term 2

English	This term, Year 3 will be writing a diary recount based on our core text, <i>Escape from Pompeii</i> . We will be thinking about the different features of diary entries, writing in the past tense and how to use descriptive and emotive language.
Maths	This term, children will continue to develop their skills in addition and subtraction, focusing on using formal written methods and solving word problems. We will also begin exploring multiplication and division, introducing arrays, equal groups, and times tables to build a strong foundation for future learning.
Science	This term, children will learn about animals including humans and understand their diets and characteristics. Pupils will also learn about the importance of nutrition, skeletons, and muscles, and how these help animals (including humans) move and stay healthy.
Geography	This term, children will learn what rivers are and explore how they are formed and used. They will discover the different parts of a river and how rivers support human activity, such as transport, farming, and providing environment.
PSHE	This term, children will explore the importance of respecting and valuing differences in others. Through discussions and activities, they will learn about diversity, empathy, and how to build positive relationships. Pupils will also develop skills to recognise and challenge stereotypes and celebrate what makes each person unique.
Music/MFL	This term, children will learn to locate France on a map and name a Francophone country. They will practise key greetings and learn to ask and answer simple questions like "How are you?" and "What is your name?" in French. Pupils will also count to ten and recognise ten colours in French through fun activities.
Computing	This term, children will begin learning the basics of spreadsheets using PurpleMash, including how to input data and use simple formulas. We will also continue exploring online safety, helping pupils understand how to stay safe on the internet.
RE	This term, Year 3 will be continuing exploring the question 'What do different people believe about God?' We will look at different religions and people's views.
PE	This term, children will develop their skills in team sports through hockey and basketball. They will learn key techniques such as passing, dribbling, and shooting, while also building teamwork, spatial awareness, and understanding of game rules.
Art/DT	This term, children will explore food technology by learning about healthy eating and where food comes from. They will plan and prepare simple dishes, developing practical skills such as chopping, mixing, and measuring ingredients safely.

Core Text



"Jemmy Button" by Jennifer Uman & Valerio Vidali.

Jemmy Button is a beautifully illustrated story inspired by true events. It follows a young boy from Tierra del Fuego who is taken to England in the 1800s, given the name "Jemmy Button," and introduced to Western culture. The story explores themes of identity, belonging, and cultural exchange, culminating in Jemmy's return to his homeland.

In Reading, we will be practicing the skills of inference, prediction, comprehension, retrieval and summarising, using the text to support our answers and explain our reasoning.
