



Year 4 — Term 4

English	In writing we will be learning about how to write a narrative poem based on Oliver and the Seawigs, and writing a persuasive speech.
Maths	In Maths, we will be learning about length and perimeter, understanding fractions and using decimals.
Science	In Science, we will be learning about digestion, including the role of the teeth, the parts of the digestive system, and all about food chains.
Geography	In Geography, we will be learning about how our food choices impact the environment, where our food comes from, and how chocolate is made!
PSHE	In PSHE, we will be learning about who helps us and keeps us safe, how we can keep ourselves safe and how to make healthy choices.
Music	In Music, we will be learning about the history of Rock and Roll music, learning how to play the Hand Jive and Rock Around the Clock and performing a piece as a class.
Computing	In computing, we will be understanding how to use spreadsheets, including using different formulae to perform functions.
RE	In RE, we will be continuing with our focus on Christianity and understanding why some people believe Jesus is an inspiration.
PE	In PE, we will be practicing the different skills of cricket and football, developing our hand-eye coordination and understanding the rules of the games.
Art/DT	In DT, we will be learning about British inventors and experimenting with the different techniques that they developed.
MFL	In Spanish, we will be learning how to talk about our family members.
