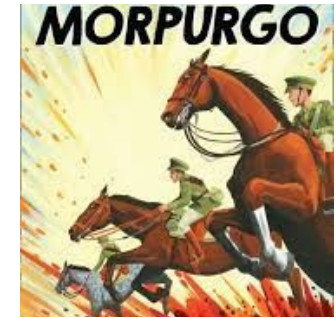




Year 6 — Term 1
