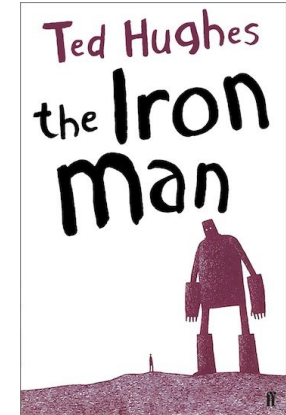




Year 3 — Term 1

English	This term, Year 3 will be writing a diary recount based on Ted Hughes' 'Iron Man'. We will be thinking about the different features of diary entries, writing in the past tense and how to use descriptive and emotive language,
Maths	In Maths, we will be starting with Place Value, addition and subtraction. We will be thinking about hundreds, tens and ones and using resources to help us add and take away two numbers.
Science	Our unit is Magnets and Forces. We will be learning about how magnets work, what gravity is and how friction can slow down moving objects. We will also be experimenting with magnets and which materials are magnetic.
History	In History, we will be learning all about the Victorians. We will be looking at what school was like during the Victorian times, what inventions were made and how the Industrial revolution affected life in the Victorian era.
PSHE	This terms unit is Me and My Relationships. We will be thinking about our friends and how to look out for our special people.
Music	Year 3 will be learning to tell stories through music, paying close attention to the dynamics, pitch and tempo and how they change and creating compositions to match an animation.
Computing	We will learning some basic coding using PurpleMash. We will also be looking at online safety and how we can stay safe on the internet.
RE	This term, Year 3 will be exploring the question 'What do different people believe about God?' We will look at different religions and people's views.
PE	This term the children will be taking part in weekly swimming lessons. We will also have hockey with a coach from St Michaels.
Art/DT	In DT this half term, we will be learning about Georges Seurat and experimenting with pointillism, creating our own pointillism paintings.
MFL	In Spanish we will be learning how to pronounce some common Spanish phonetic spellings, some greetings in Spanish, and about Spanish culture.
